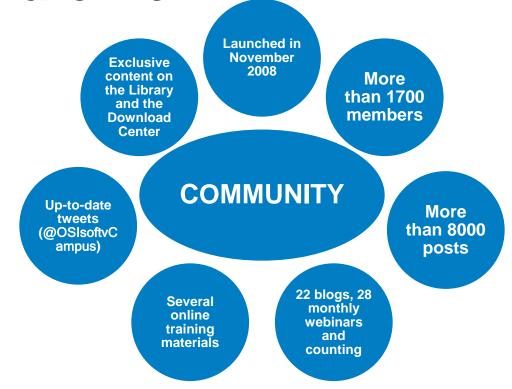

Why cloaking devices?

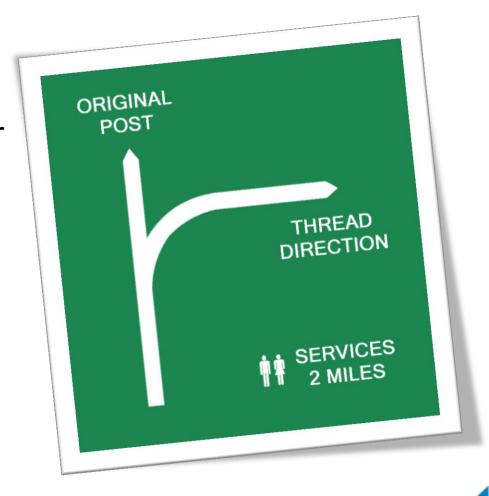

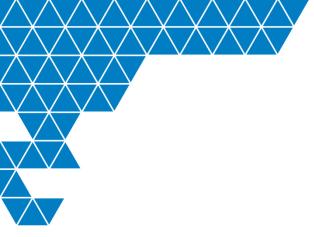
