## **Benefits of Office 2007**

- Faster Excel Calculation Engine
- Hard Coded Limits Increased
- New Formatting Features

# **Faster Calculation Engine**

- Improved performance of calculation engine
  - All formulas are executed faster
  - Should result in faster DataLink results



# **Hard Coded Limits Increased**

- 1,048,576 rows by 16,384 columns
  - Columns now end at XFD instead of IV
    - cdt158 is now an actual valid cell reference!
  - Can put more data on spreadsheet
- 255 character limit increased to 32k
- Many more limits have been increased



# **New Formatting Features**

- Reports more visually pleasing
  - Data Bars are colored bars in cell itself
  - Conditional Formatting easier in Office 2007




# DataLink 3.1.5 in Office 2007

- Calculated Functions return start, end, min/max time of calculated period
- Support for structured annotations

## DataLink 3.1.5 in Office 2007


DataLink add-in part of the "Add-Ins" Tab



- New Icons on Ribbon Menu
  - Easier to figure out functionality of menu items




- Super Tooltips are right off the ribbon
  - Easier to figure out what the function is







- Grouping of Menu Items
  - Subtle grouping in previous versions
  - "Chunks" make grouping much more apparent




- Favorites
  - Fill out fields more quickly
  - Ability to add custom favorites






- Dialogs replaced by Custom Task Pane
- Drives all pasting of DataLink functions





 Easier to make changes to arguments of DataLink functions



## DataLink Functions on the Web

- Deploy DataLink functions at enterprise level:
  - Install Sharepoint 2007 on the server machine
  - Install DataLink functions on the server machine
- No DataLink or Excel installation on client
  - Easy to upgrade everyone at once
  - One Version of Truth



## DataLink Functions on the Web

- Not able to directly edit cells on spreadsheet
- Parameter list enables to change cells
- Parameters are named ranges on the spreadsheet
- Make existing spreadsheets portable to Sharepoint portal



# DataLink Functions on the Web

- RtWebParts Interaction
  - Excel web part as a consumer
  - RtWebParts as a provider
    - For example, "context" (tag name, start/end time, etc.) can be sent from RtTreeView
    - DataLink Server automatically recalculates and updated results are displayed in Excel web part



# The Central Theme: SEA

- Simple
  - Ribbon makes it simpler to use
  - DataLink on Excel Server makes it simpler to deploy and manage installations
  - Enterprise Aware
- DataLink on Excel Server is nice way to deploy DataLink at enterprise level
- Highly Available
  - With the new SDK and its support of PI server collectives, data availability should increase
