

Project Scope

- This project consists of Eastman sites worldwide.
- Seven of the manufacturing sites utilize the PI System and PIMS software.
 - Four International and three US plant sites.
- We have approximately 5000 client machines that utilize the PI System
 - Approximately 150 Eastman PIMS applications that rely on the basic PI System



Results


 Over 500 employees participated in the Early Adopter "Volunteer" Program.

Initial laptop tests proved increased productivity and performance.


Survey feedback has been positive!

Benefits

- PIMS Manufacturing Image 1 FTE
- Vendor alignment (DCS, Lab)



Learnings

- Users really like the following updates in PI ProcessBook
 - Data Favorites, Drag & Drop, Browser Add-in, and SQC Symbol
- Users really like the following updates in PI DataLink
 - PI Ribbon
- Problem with saving MS Excel Spreadsheets in Office 2010 with PI DataLink 2010 and PowerPivot COM objects loaded.
- Customized Alarm notifications no longer display in System Tray.
- Problem with Calendar Control in several of our customized applications.



Future Plans

- Deploy PI System software and PIMS standard/corporate client applications utilizing Microsoft Application Virtualization (App-V)
 - This will remove the need for the manufacturing image
 - Managed application upgrades
