



The SQL Family


- Set of drivers that expose PI System data in a relational database view (OLE DB, JDBC, ODBC)
- Database systems integration, analysis, BI, reporting, Linux



Production/Consumption Profiling




Production/Consumption Analytics






Maps with Operational Data




New in our SQL Family (2010 R3)

- Performance improvements and reduced memory footprint
- "Bottom-up" and "By Musiches
- SQL Language Additions
 - LEFT OUTER JOWive me the current load
 - USE <catalog all meters of type 'Commercial'
- Error handling options can be set globally, via the Connection String ...in a 2.5 million meter system
- Support for writing to High Availability PI System ...where 91% of the meters are of type 'Residential'







New in PI Web Services 2010 R3

- Performance improvements
- Data by exception (a.k.a. sign up for updates)
- Support for writing to High Availability PI System
- Improved installation experience
 - Including silent installs and the ability to host in a service (no IIS)



What's Coming Next

- More assets, more events
 - Support for PI Event Frames
 (PI OLEDB Enterprise, PI JDBC and PI Web Services)
 - AF Search/Navigation and writing AF Attribute values (PI Web Services)

- Support for "the other type" of web services
 - A RESTful service (OData)



PI Data Access, longer-term

PI System SDK

A single high performance SDK that allows you to access all PI System data

RESTful Web Services

Emerging web service standard, ideally suited for mobile and cloud

Integration Services

Makes business system integration easy, not just possible (ERP, BI)


